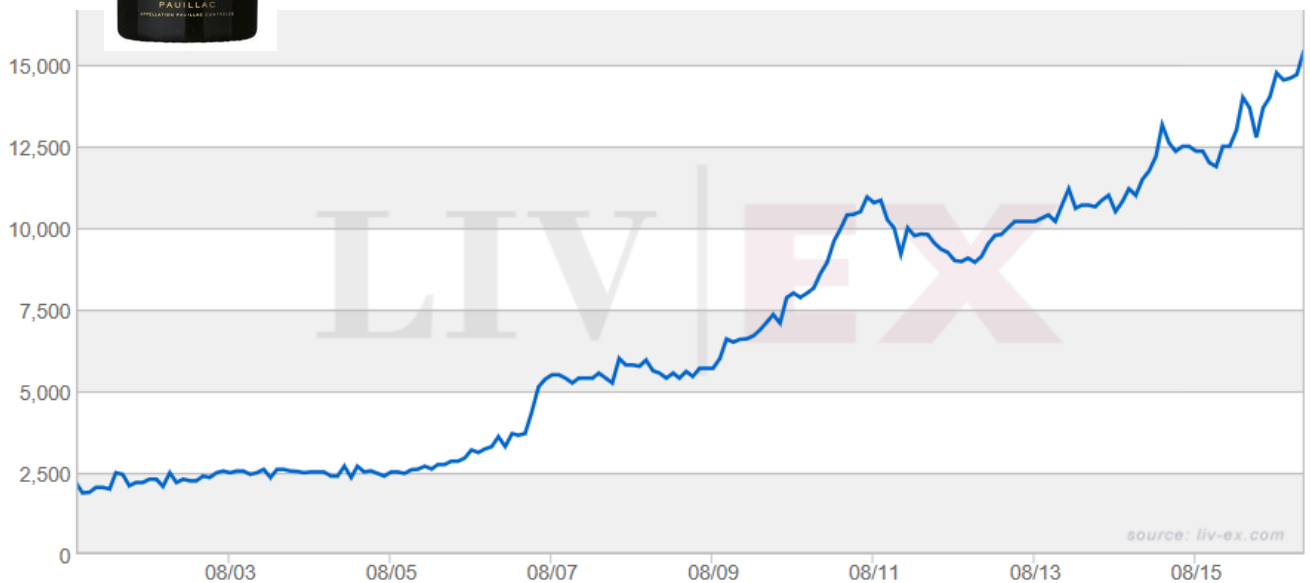

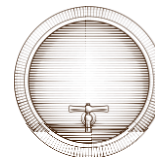

The Future

Château Mouton Rothschild 2000 has remained an incredibly attractive investment, with its price continuing to rise consistently, especially as other wines, particularly a number of First Growths, lost much of their value through the various financial crashes. There are no signs of any plateau to this wine's inexorable march as it continues to appreciate, and so it is highly recommended as part of a Fine Wine Investment portfolio.

2000 was both an excellent vintage and a Millennial year, so there is an extra allure to this Mouton, augmented by the sought-after gold-embossed bottles which have only increased desirability. Despite it not having 100 points, this wine is a perfect example of the potential long-term gains of investing in the Bordeaux First Growths from excellent vintages.
